### A FEW FRIENDLY REMINDERS...

- ✓ Please clearly label all of your child's belongings, including water bottles and bed sheets
- ✓ Please bring 1 piece of fruit or vegetable each day
- $\checkmark$  Please call us to notify us if your child will not be attending care for any reason
- ✓ Please do not leave medication in your child's bag
- ✓ Please check Kinderloop regularly to avoid missing out on any important information, upcoming events or notifications
- ✓ Please notify us if someone different will be collecting your child from the centre
- ✓ Please update us with any medical information such as change in allergies, dietary requirements etc
- ✓ Please keep your child's immunisation records up to date with us
- ✓ Please notify us of any changes to your contact details, or emergency contact details.

#### CCS AND ATTENDANCE:

Our digital sign in and out system is now live, and attendances are automatically linked and sent directly to Centrelink. Therefor it is vital that you remember to sign your children in and out each time they attend the centre. Please ensure that any grandparents, family members or friends who may collect your children are aware of this process also.

Centrelink now bill us in fortnightly sessions, so it is important that fees are paid fortnightly, so it is important that you pay fees fortnightly as each session is billed. We recommend setting up reoccurring payments from your bank account into ours to avoid any overlap of fees and sessions.

## SCHOOL READINESS WITH JUST FOR KIDS:

Our School readiness program will begin in February 2019. This year all children in the Smarties room will be included in the School readiness program and will each receive their own workbooks. These workbooks include prewriting activities that promote and encourage the exploration of literacy and numeracy skills through educator lead and directed interactions and experiences. The children who will not be attending primary school next year will begin with basic activities that introduce letters, numbers, shapes etc. and the children will work with our educators to develop and maintain the correct pencil grip and control whilst exploring and learning through play. For the Smarties who will be attending primary school in 2020, we have developed a more comprehensive and intense school readiness workbook and program to ensure they develop all of the necessary skills that are required for a smooth transition to formal schooling.

Whilst our workbooks will lay the foundation for our school readiness program, we will still have a big emphasis of "learning through play" by implementing play-based learning opportunities for the children daily.

We are looking forward to watching your children learn and grow with us in the Smarties room this year!
